Charles Garrett Memorial Hunt 2017 Edition

A Fitting Tribute to Our Founder

In the deep piney woods of East Texas, just a stone's throw away from the Louisiana border, hundreds of treasure hunters gathered on the weekend of April 1 to celebrate the life of detecting pioneer Charles Lewis Garrett.

The 2017 Charles Garrett Memorial Hunt—held on the birthday of the late co-founder of Garrett Metal Detectors—was a fun-filled weekend that would have brought a smile to his face. Diggers from 26 different states, plus people from Canada and Italy, made their way to Jefferson, Texas, to partake in the festivities.

The hunt took place within the 200-acre property of Diamond Don's RV Park, situated along Big Cypress Bayou. Jefferson was an important commercial riverboat town around the period of the Civil War, so historic finds were expected beyond just the relics and silver coins planted by the Garrett team. The memorial hunt, in fact, included a "best finds" contest revolving around natural finds of coins, relics, and Texana artifacts dug by the detectorists.

Garrett's Code of Detecting Ethics

Charles Garrett always urged his fellow searchers to conduct themselves as responsible treasure hunters and to leave their hunt areas in better condition than they found them. Here are just a few of his keys to good conduct in the field:



- Never trespass or hunt on private property without permission.
- National and state parks/monuments, etc. are absolutely off-limits.
- Always fill in every hole that you dig.
- Do not leave litter or other discarded junk items lying around.
- Always carry out all rubbish and dug targets with you when you leave a search area.
- Use reasonable caution in digging toward any target, particularly in areas where you are uncertain of the ground conditions.
- Keep informed on and obey all local and national legislation relating to the discovery and reporting of found treasures.

The Best Finds contest was judged by detecting celebrities Michael "Nugget Noggin" Bennett, Tim "Ringmaster" Saylor, and George "KG" Wyant. Each of the four category winners was awarded a new Garrett ACE 400 metal detector. Many historic items were dug from the old Jefferson town dump, located on the RV park's property.

Dozens of bottle diggers had a field day digging trenches once our local assistant Willie Turlington removed vast quantities of topsoil with his excavator. No coins or relics were planted in the old dump areas, so all finds made in that region of the park were true native finds. Garrett did plant numerous prize tokens and coin caches throughout other areas of the "free range" hunt acreage.

We were truly blessed with terrific weather for the hunts on Friday and Saturday. The Saturday morning Relic Hunt included nearly 200 searchers, who scoured a large chunk of land that included both open fields and wooded areas. In addition to numerous hidden prize tokens, the contestants had the chance to dig Civil War artillery shells,



cannon balls, more than 1,000 eagle buttons and flat buttons, and 5,000 minié balls and musket balls.

The prize tokens from the Relic Hunt were redeemable for *Pro-Pointers*, Garrett detectors, accessories, Civil War artifacts, gold coins, and many other prizes donated by our generous sponsors. These gifts included relic shovels, magazine subscriptions, relic identification books, gift cards, silver relic coin proofs, and more. Please take note of the sponsor list included in this edition of the *Searcher*. We can't express our thanks enough to these fine folks who went above and beyond the call to add extra excitement to the sport of metal detecting. (See page 9)

Prizes were awarded after each big hunt by hunt master Rusty Curry and prize master Adam Lewis. Heim, Terry Smith, Tom Moss, and more. Many of the East Texas area treasure hunters also assisted Rusty with planting the hunt fields.

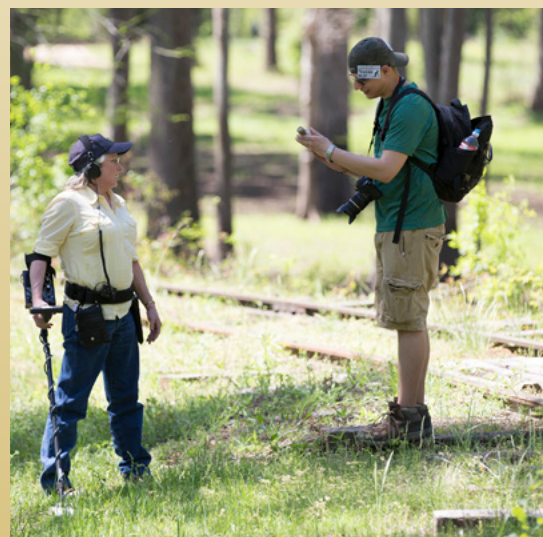
Saturday evening was capped off by a fireworks show, courtesy of Don and Francene Rainey, followed by the Lights Out night hunt. More than 300 detectorists hurried about in the dark to find coins, jewelry and tokens—without the benefit of any pinpointers or lights.

Sunday's big Silver Hunt looked like it might be a wash-out, as nasty storms were threatening. Fortunately, we were able to get in about 90 minutes of hunt time before lightning forced us to close the hunt for the sake of everyone's safety. The searchers worked swiftly, and by all appearances, they pulled the vast majority of the nearly 10,000 silver coins planted from the hunt area.

So far, emails and survey responses sent in from attendees have been very positive. Here is how one of the treasure hunters rated the 2017 Charles Garrett Memorial Hunt: "The best hunt in my 25 years of going to hunts from Virginia to Nevada. I attend approximately ten hunts per year."

On behalf of the Garrett staff and all of those who assisted us, we appreciate such response and thank you for helping us remember our founder in such a fun way this year.

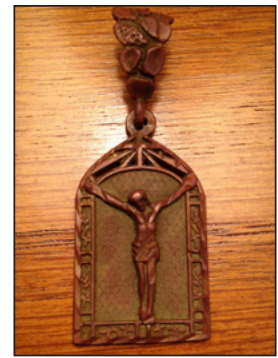

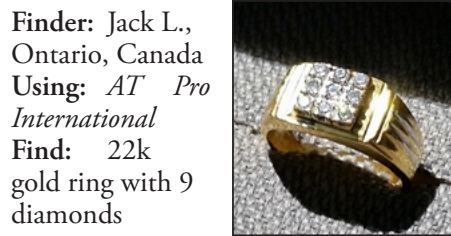

In the November 2016 issue, the *Garrett Searcher* featured a find made by Tommy B. of Glenrothes, United Kingdom. Tommy has since reached out to share the fact that this Scottish silver hammered William I “The Lion” coin has been claimed under Scottish law and now belongs to the National Museum of Scotland.

Tommy is thrilled to have unearthed such a rare 900-year-old hammered coin. He originally started detecting with a Garrett *EuroACE* as a means of exercise following cancer treatment. His interest in digging old coins continued, so Tommy stepped up to the *AT Pro*, which he was using when he made this recovery near Edinburgh.
