

U.S. Searchers Make Big Finds Abroad

Those American metal detectorists who are fortunate enough to occasionally travel overseas know just how old, and how exciting, their finds can be in other countries.

Two such people who have sent in their stories to Garrett are Ellen J. of Dallas, Texas, and Thibault D. from Mamaroneck, New York. Their stories are quite different but they were each excited by what they experienced.

Ellen, a member of the Lone Star Treasure Hunters Club, has spent the past four summers volunteering as a metal detectorist on archaeological projects in Israel. Her first adventure was in May 2013 on the Khirbet el Maqatir dig, where she found herself to be the only experienced detectorist.

"From that two week dig, I was hooked," she says. "I consider it a blessing to combine two hobbies, metal detecting and archaeology, and I've been going back to Israel every summer since."

The detecting began in 2009 when she purchased a *GTI 2500* at the Texas State Fair. Ellen has since added the *ACE 250*, *AT Pro*, and the *AT Gold*. During her first season in Israel in 2013, she found more than 200 coins while helping the archaeology team.

In 2014, she raised her coin total to 300, and added another 250 coins in 2015. Ellen shared "My goal in 2016 was to cross the 1,000 coin all-time total for Khirbet el Maqatir," said Ellen. "That was done in the first week. The dig director even made a special video of the 1,000th coin. I found 200 more the next two weeks, so we topped 300 for this year and brought the all-time total to over 1,200 coins."

These coins range over many centuries, but the majority are between the 2nd century BC/BCE to 1st century AD/CE—

making them all in the neighborhood of 2,000 years old. The archaeology projects she joins usually stretch two to three weeks, and many of the low denomination bronze coins are not all beauties.

Ellen's best coin of 2016 was found using her *AT Gold*, which she uses to go back through dirt piles after sections of soil have been sifted. "I was going over new dirt in the dump when the high tone signal rang loud and clear," she said. "I used the pinpointer to zero in, brushed aside the dirt,

and my heart leapt when a large silver coin appeared."

Their Israeli numismatist identified the coin as a Tyrian silver shekel of Antiochus VII, minted in 135 BC in Tyre.

Fourteen-year-old Thibault has already been detecting for about seven years now. He had the chance to detect on private land while visiting the home of his grandparents

Garrett's Code of Detecting Ethics

Charles Garrett always urged his fellow searchers to conduct themselves as responsible treasure hunters and to leave their hunt areas in better condition than they found them. Here are just a few of his keys to good conduct in the field:



- Never trespass or hunt on private property without permission.
- National and state parks/monuments, etc. are absolutely off-limits.
- Always fill in every hole that you dig.
- Do not leave litter or other discarded junk items lying around.
- Always carry out all rubbish and dug targets with you when you leave a search area.
- Use reasonable caution in digging toward any target, particularly in areas where you are uncertain of the ground conditions.
- Keep informed on and obey all local and national legislation relating to the discovery and reporting of found treasures.

in France. He found five King Louis coins that date to the 1700s.

"That was crazy for me!" Thibault said. "It was the best find ever." He continued to hunt old fields around his grandparents' home with his *ACE 250* and managed to top his 300-year-old King Louis coins just a few days later. His best discovery came in a field where a village had once stood many years ago.


"The coin was about six inches down and rang up kind of like a ring," he said. It was a coin from the reign of King Henry III, who ruled France from 1574 to 1589.

"When I asked my parents for a metal detector, they thought I wouldn't find much because I was just a kid and didn't have much experience," Thibault said. "But Garrett machines are so good that it almost does the work for you. When I showed them this coin, they were blown away!"

In honor of our late founder, Garrett is planning a big detecting rally—the Charles Garrett Memorial Hunt, to be held during the weekend of April 1-2, 2017. Those who attend can expect plenty of fun, plenty of prizes to win, and a truly memorable weekend.

The event will be held near the small, historic town of Jefferson, Texas—once a thriving riverport in the 1800s. The Garrett hunt will feature both seeded hunts and native hunting in an area where history dating to the Civil War could potentially be dug.

The Basic Hunt package includes: a free hunt T-shirt (for those who pay before March 1st); participation in up to four prize hunts; a Saturday lunch; park admission; and tent camping in Diamond Don's RV Park, the site of the Garrett hunt. (RVs are additional cost; check directly with Diamond Don's for rates.)

The two big hunts, a Silver Hunt and a Relic Hunt, each require an additional hunt fee. There are six total hunts, each of which offer contestants the chance to win metal detectors, pinpointers, and Garrett accessories as prizes.

The free Kids' Hunt on Saturday, April 1, is open to children ages 12 and younger, and will be split into two age groups. As with each of the hunts, the field will be seeded with some special tokens that are redeemable for Garrett products.

"The Relic Hunt and the Silver Hunt are expected to be the big draws, but the Free Range hunting within the park could well produce some great finds," says Garrett marketing director Steve Moore. "The RV park sits on historic ground alongside a steamboat terminal and through which Civil War-era railroads ran. The property includes one of the oldest dumps of Jefferson, as well as the remains of a factory that helped supply the Confederates during the Civil War."

"One year ago, on the day that I had dedicated to my hobby, I went in search of new potential locations because of bad weather. From the car, I noticed all kinds of hills, forests and interesting places. I marked them to check if there were archaeological sites.

"At one point, I noticed a very interesting hill because of its position—a hill isolated from the rest—with a river at the base. I told myself, *Surely, it was a Bronze Age settlement, it has all the features.* I wanted to get there in one of my trips.

"The problem is that I simply forgot that hill, and now, a year later, it came back to mind again. So, I took two of my boys and I went to go detect with my Garrett *AT Pro International* to see if my intuition was good.

"When we reached the hill, I left the car at the edge of the forest and we began to climb in order to reach the top of the hill. The ascent was quite difficult due to the steep slopes. We reached the top and there I started to scan. After the fourth hole, I found the first coin, then another, and another . . . up to 220 coins. They were widespread, so collecting them was quite difficult. They were found over an area of 35-40 square meters and at depth of 5 to 30 centimeters."

The hoard was handed over to the History Museum in Brasov.
